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Report of the Trustees For The Year Ended 31 March 2018

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2018. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Charitable Purposes

The Principal objective of the Car Scheme is to benefit of the elderly, disabled, mentally disadvantaged and geographically isolated residents of South West Ross-shire by providing voluntary transport services.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable Activities

During the year the Charity obtained the services of 11 telephonists (2017 - 13) and 27 volunteer drivers (2017 - 27) and undertook around 58 journeys per month (2017 - 57).

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial Performance

For the period under review the Charity had a Surplus of income over expenditure of £6405 (2017 - £8719).

Reserves policy

The Charity's reserves are held to further its objectives of providing a voluntary transport service for the residents of south west Ross-shire.

Donated facilities and services

The trustees donate their time in order to achieve the primary objective of the trust.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The Charity was formed under a constitution dated May 2003. The Charity was formed as a company limited by guarantee on 6 July 2006 and is regulated by its Memorandum and Articles of Association. Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of South West Ross Community Car Scheme

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and fittings

- 25% on reducing balance

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The charitable company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the charitable company's pension scheme are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.
